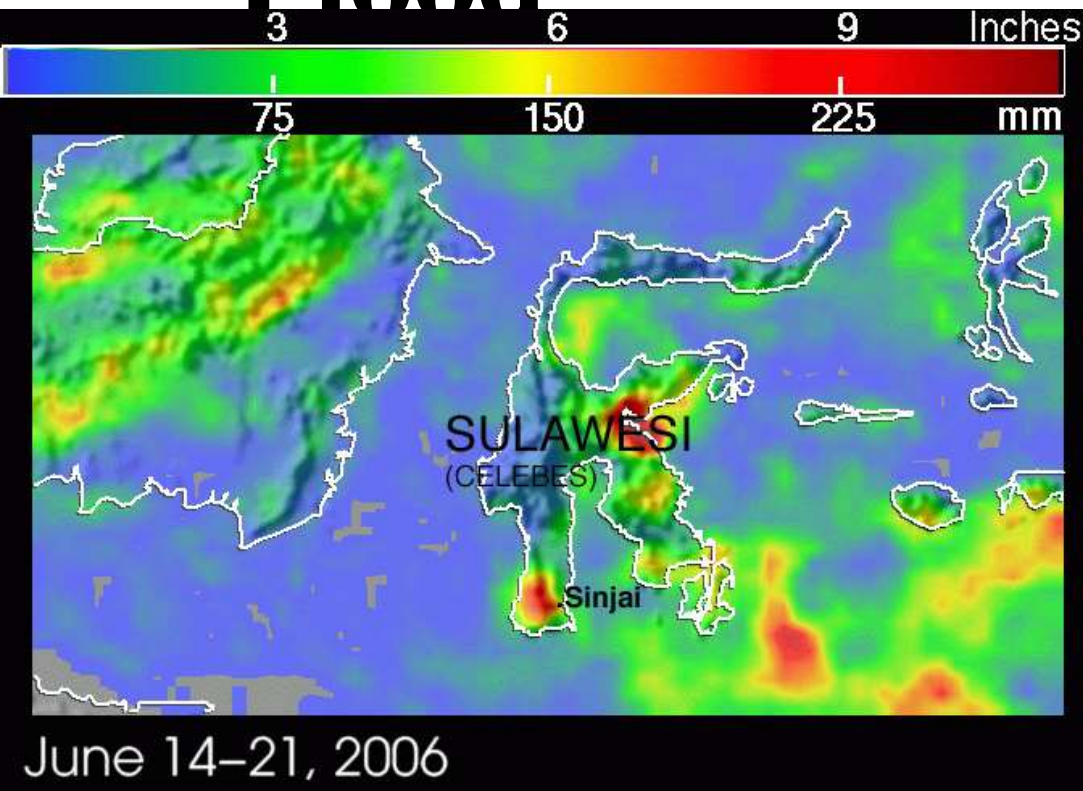

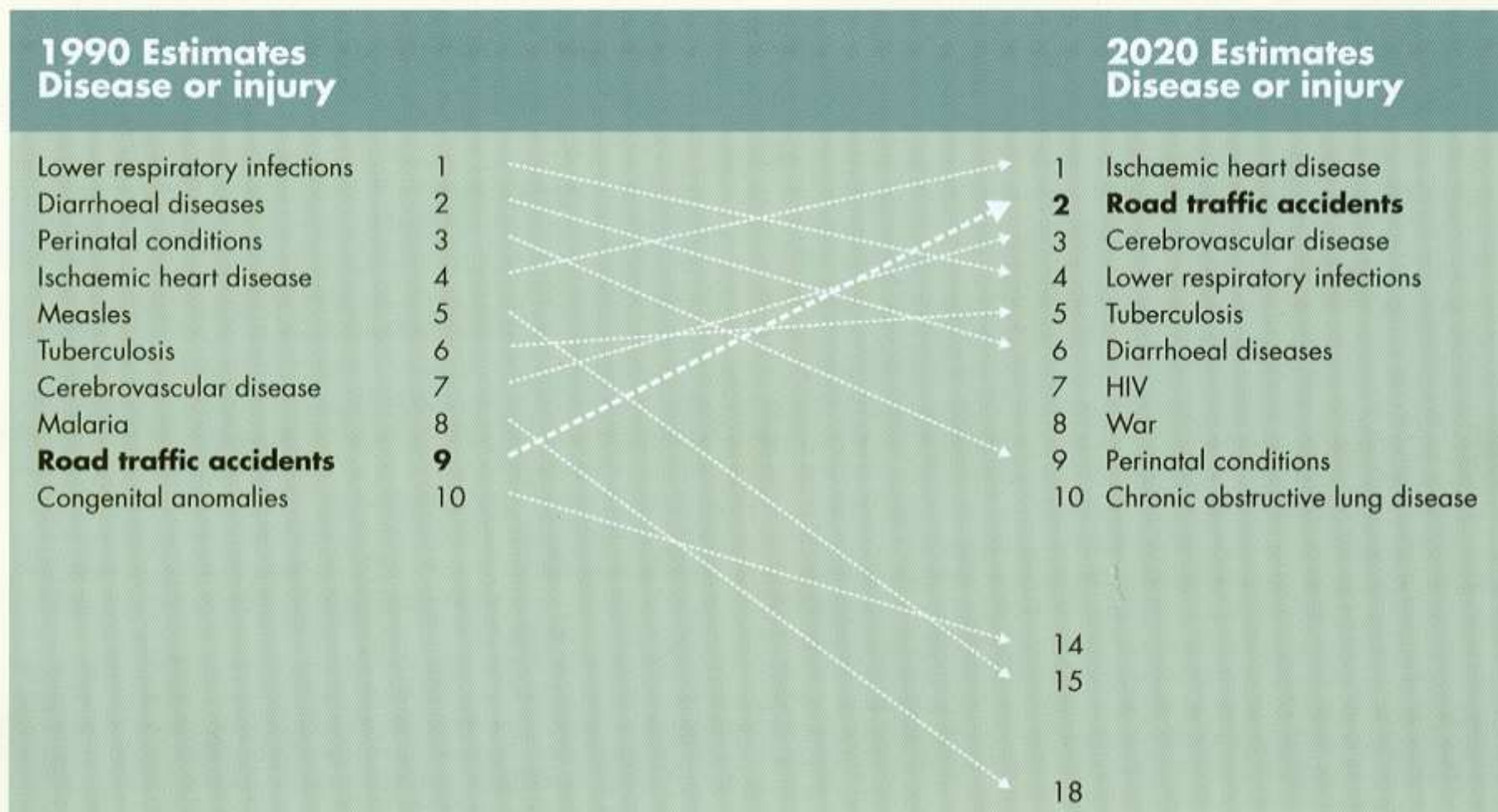


Figure 1. Ranking of injuries among all leading causes of death in the South-East Asia Region, 2001 Estimates (4).

Box 1. Change in rank order of years of life lost for the 10 leading causes worldwide, 1990 -2020 (3).

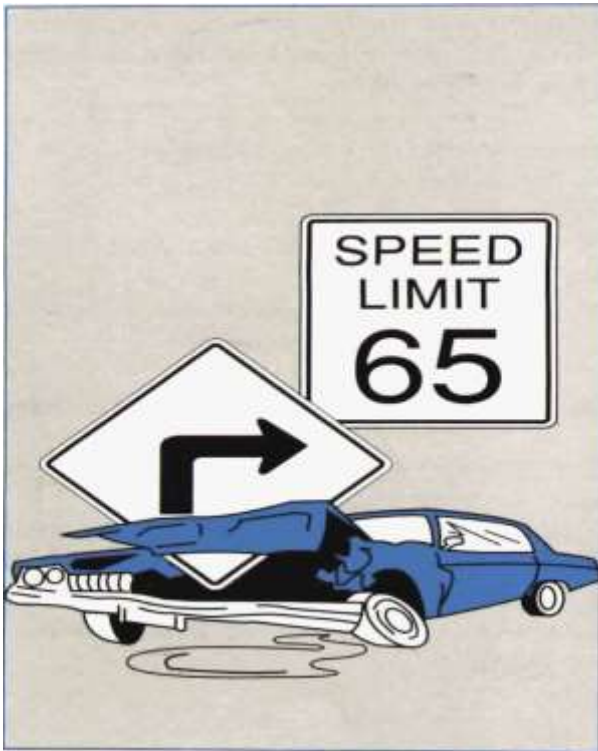

1. train specialists in Disaster medical management
2. Create a Disaster Medicine Education program for Makassar, Indonesia
3. Train at least 50- master Trainers for the program and these, in turn, will help train many more disaster medical workers
